Introduction

This is the 2022 annual report for Kids Promise. In this report we list our accomplishments for 2022 and set goals and budgets for the coming year. We believe that this report will provide you with an overview of the activities and efforts of Kids Promise in supporting its mission.

Building New Homes

Kids Promise built 6 homes for poor families in 2022. Details of those efforts are noted below.

1. Charity Home #34

House #34 was built on January 28th, 2022 in Phu Cuong hamlet, Phu Huu commune, Chau Thanh district, Dong Thap province for Ms. Diep's family, with her only son Vo Tan Phong and grandson Vo Hoang Luc, a student in grade 9. The house that Ms. Diep's family lived in before construction was the kitchen area of the house that was built over 26 years ago and collapsed.

The spring of 2022 is so memorable for Ms. Dinh Ngoc Diep's family, because her whole family can gather together in happiness to welcome a new year's gift which Ms. Diep wished for it at the age of 70.

The charity house that Kids Promise was built for Ms. Diep's family has an area of about 48m², reinforced concrete foundation, ceramic tile lining, plastering and whitewashing the whole house. In addition to the house, Ms. Diep was also given a furniture gift set including a bed, a dining table, a study table, 10 chairs and a fan. The entire cost to complete the house number 34 was sponsored by Maggie and Wardwell Johnson of Minneapolis, Minnesota

2. Charity Home #35

On May 14, 2022, the representative of Kids Promise presented the house number 35 in Dinh Quan town, Dinh Quan district, Dong Nai province to the family of Mr. Chau Kha and Ms. Pham Le Quyen. Their family has 4 children: the youngest child is 2 years old, the other two are in 6th and 2nd grade. The main source of the family income is from Mr. Kha's work as a pallbearer, and it is too little to afford the whole family cost of living. They are obviously powerless to repair, strengthen, and prevent leaks of the house. Therefore, Kids Promise has considered and decided to give the charity house number 35 to Mr. Kha family.

The house has been built with an area of 48 m², reinforced concrete foundation, brick columns, lined with ceramic tiles, plastered and whitewashed the whole house. In addition to receiving a love house, Chau Kha's family was also given furniture including 1 study table, 10 plastic chairs and 1 round dining table. We hope this new house will motivate the family to improve their financial situation and education for the children.

3. Charity Home #36

Charity House 36 was built on July 15th, 2022 in a mountainous area in the central region of Vietnam. The lucky family to receive this house is the family of Mr. Phan Van Tinh, Ms. Tran Thi Yen and 2 children in Hamlet 3, Tien An commune, Tien Phuoc province, Quang Nam province.

The house before construction was built homemade, and the space is just enough for daily activities of the family. Life in the mountain area has a lot of difficulties in economic activities and the labor market. The family has tried to do a lot of odd jobs but still doesn't have enough money to rebuild a cozy and solid house.

Kids Promise has decided to give charity house number 36 to the family in order to help them have a solid home to improve their finance in the future. In addition to receiving a charity house, the family of Mr. Tinh and Ms. Yen were also given a furniture gift set including a student desk, 10 plastic chairs and a round dining table. All construction and interior costs are sponsored by Phong Ly (New Jersey), Thuy Le (Seattle), My Chi Vo & Friends (Minnesota), Dung Luong (California), Nghia Doan (Seattle).

The total expense is 67,000,000 VND (~\$2,931 USD) for this house.

4. Charity Home #37

On September 17th, 2022, Representative of Kids Promise attended the handover ceremony for the house #37 to the family of Mr. Nguyen Van Quan & Mrs. Lam Ngoc Vien at Nam Do Hamlet, Tan Phuoc Commune, Dong Phu District, Binh Phuoc Province. With the participation of local people's committee, the handover ceremony successfully took place and marked the next step of stability and development of the family to focus on their children's education.

Mr. Quan's family has 5 members which includes the parents and 3 children. The oldest girl and 2 younger brothers were born in 2008, 2011 and 2019 respectively. He and his wife were hired labor, the hired work includes picking cashew nuts, pepper, coffee, firewood and other odd jobs. The work was inconsistent with an average daily wage of approximately 200,000VND – 300,000VND. Luckily, his wife recently has got a job as a worker for a footwear development company, the basis salary is 4.1 million which is not included overtime working. Due to Mr. Quan's health issue, he just stays at home and takes care the children.

Kids Promise has decided to give charity house number 37 to this family in order to help them have a solid home to improve their finance in the future. In addition to receiving a charity house, the family of Mr. Quan was also given a furniture gift set, the budget is around 65,000,000VND for construction.

5. Charity Home #38

On December 17th, 2022, after 2 months of constructing Kids Promise appeared in Dong Nai province to hand out the 38th charity house to another poor family of five people: Mr. Duong Van Lam (born 1976), Mrs. To Thi Dung (1978), 2 daughters (2010, 2022), 1 son (2012). Mr. Lam's family is originally from Southwestern region and moved to Dong Nai to live following the new economic zone.

They're currently living in a remote mountainous area where not many people can access because roads are hard to travel to. In addition doing some jobs such as rubber scraping, weeding, bricklaying, Mr. Lam and Mrs. Dung have also worked as beef cattle workers. However, the income is just enough to cover the cost of living for 5 people.

The family has lived here for 20 years, and the original handmade house was built 10 years ago with some small pillars and corrugated iron around. In the rainy season, it still leaks, and the house is too cranky to face big storms because most of the pillars are eaten by termites. The family always desires to have a new stable safe house, yet their income is just enough for living's expenses. And the dream of a safe house seems to be out of their hands.

After considering the family's difficult circumstance, the charity group Kids Promise donated house number 38 to the family of Mr. Lam, Ms. Dung and 3 children. The house was built with an area of 48m² including a front yard, 1 living room, 1 bedroom, 1 toilet and a kitchen outside the house. The siblings of Mr. Lam supported a small amount of constructing expenses to help the family have a better place to live.

6. Charity Home #39

The house number 39 is the last house Kids Promise built in 2022. The family that received this house is Mr. Cong and Ms. Hai's family, living in Tan Nghia hamlet, Tan Thuan Dong commune, Chau Thanh district, Dong Thap province.

Mr. Cong is a house builder and paid by the day, Ms. Hai is a pangasius stomach process worker, the average salary is about 100,000 VND/day, the rest of the time she is at home raising chickens and taking care of children.

The original house that the family was living in was cranky, dank and old . It was built on the side of the parents' house for more than 10 years, and the function was just to cover the rain and the sun only. The family has a dream to build a stable house of their own, but the current income situation is just enough for living expenses.

Realizing the difficult situation of Mr. Cong's family, the charity group has sent a proposal to the Board of Directors of the Kids Promise charity group. We decided to donate the house number 39 to the family of Mr. Cong, Ms. Hai and her daughter Hanh and a furniture gift set including a desk and a bed.

Repairing Charity Homes

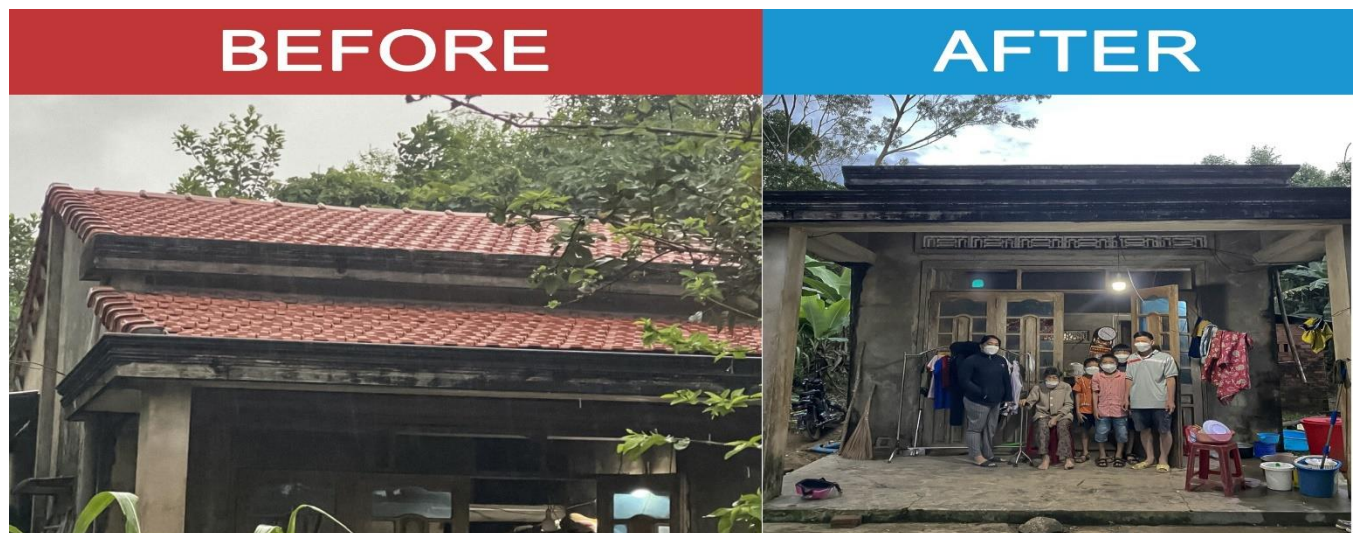

Mr. Thai Viet Truong is currently living with his 83-year-old mother and three sons (named Nam, Xuan and Dat), Mr. Truong's wife just had a stroke and died a year ago.

The second son, Nam, unfortunately has blood cancer, the other two sons are of school age. His family used to earn enough to live and raise their children to study. They also had a piece of land, but since Nam got sick, his family's finance has become more difficult.

The current house he has built for a long time. Although it was solid, now the tile roof has collapsed, it has leaked a lot. With the desire to replace the tile roof to make the house more cozy in the coming stormy days, the Kids Promise Charity Group and local people have provided financial aid to replace it for his family.

Now the tile roof has been completely replaced on June 01st, 2022, Kids Promise hopes that his family has a safe place to live, a cozy space to gather together. This is a big motivation for them to overcome difficulties and challenges in life. Wishing the family good health, happiness and a bright future.
