Introduction

This is the 2021 annual report for Kids Promise. In this report we list our accomplishments for 2021 and set goals and budgets for the coming year. We believe that this report will provide you with an overview of the activities and efforts of Kids Promise in supporting its mission.

2021 Project Summary

Although COVID limited our ability to meet our goals for home building, Kids Promise was still able to complete two homes

1. Charity Home #32

In May 2021! The representatives of Kids Promise held a ceremony to present the home #32 to the family of Mr. Le Van Tuan and Mrs. Đào Thi Roi at Tan Vinh hamlet, Tan Lap commune, Tan Phuoc district, Tien Giang province. The house is 42m² (~380 sq ft) which includes a front yard, living room, bedroom, and bathroom. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 issue in Vietnam, this is the first charity home build for 2021.

Kids Promise visited this family a year ago, Mr. Le and Mrs. Dao had 2 school age children and a newborn baby. Mr. Le is a disable person with the condition of aphasia disorder. Because of his current condition, it is very difficult for him to make a decent living to support his family. Mrs. Dao also works to support her family but her job as a farmer and gardening barely enough support her family.

Kids Promise visited them again this year and the family living condition was in bad shape, the roof was leaking during the raining season and the foundation started to crumble. The home was not safe for their children and might not make it to this year raining season. With their current income level, they would never have enough saving to fit or remodel their current home.

The ceremony took place successfully with the participation of neighbors, local government officials and representatives of Kids Promise to congratulate and shared the happy day with the family. With the new home handover to the family, we hope this will create a good foundation for the family moving forward. During the ceremony, the family also thanked Kids Promise for giving the charity home #32 and wished the organization would continue to strive and support more houses build for less fortunate families in Vietnam.

2. Charity Home #33

Charity House #33 has completed and was given to the family of Mr. Phong & Mrs. Luu in November 2021. The ceremony took place but there were not many participants due to Covid 19. More than the charity house, the family was also sponsored a bed, a desk and dinner table set which cost around 4.600.000VND. The representative of Kids Promise sent congratulations to the family and hopes for the family of overcoming the poverty. Mr. Phong and Ms. Luu also thanked Kids Promise and sponsors for giving them a safe house.

Mr. Phong and Mrs. Luu have two children who are in grades nine and six. The older child has postponed her studies because the parents have had financial difficulties. She left school to go to work to support her parents. They are farmers and took a loan from the bank to do the farming in large scale. Unfortunately, the harvest was not as successful as expected after several trial seasons. They returned their rental land and continued working for hire while accumulating money to pay for their debts. Their jobs included cultivating rice, mustering rice, and spraying chemicals. They are working so hard, but their income could not cover for all the family expenses and children's school fees. They have been living in this current house for over 16 years. The columns are damaged by termites, the decayed iron roof causes water leaking that awakens them all night in the rainy season. They had hoped to have money to repair their house, but they could not do anything with such a limited amount of money.

Repair Charity House

Kids Promise sponsored to repair the house for the family of Mrs. Nguyen Phuong Tuyen at 416, An Hung hamlet, An Khanh commune, Chau Thanh district, Dong Thap province. The family has four members: Mrs. Tuyen, her mom and two children.

Mrs. Tuyen's family belongs to a poor household in the hamlet. Her dad died two years ago. Her husband left home for a long time but never came back. She is now living with her mom and children. Her main income is from selling lottery tickets. Her mom does the gardening and sells vegetables that she collects from the garden to support Mrs. Tuyen. Due to the poverty, the elder brother no longer goes to school. He tried to earn money from a part time job but when the Covid-19 pandemic hit Vietnam, he became unemployed. Only the younger sister who is in grade six is attending school.

The house in which she is currently living was the charity house sponsored by the Government twelve years ago. As the budget was just 12 million, the structure of the house was built as simply as possible. The house is now in bad condition and in need of repair. The roof has cracks and the floor is damp. Mrs. Tuyen's income, is just enough to cover the family's basic supplies. Her dream of repairing the house won't happen as she doesn't have financial capacity.

The representative of Kids Promise has visited and understands the circumstances of this family and the effort of the parents to provide for their children's future. Kids Promise would like to request the Management Board to consider approving a budget of 20 million VND (\$878.93 USD) for repairing the house which includes rebuilding the wall, replacing the roof, and renewing the floor.
